**“God Is Not A Respector of Persons, But God Is A Respector of Faith”**

**Scripture References: Hebrews 11:6; Romans 2:11**

1. In Sunday’s message, Pastor MGB cites Romans 2:11, which states that “there is no respect of persons with God.”

What does it mean to “be a respector of persons?”

If God is not a respector of persons, why are some believers blessed while other believers are not?

2. Hebrews 11:6 says “without faith it is impossible to please Him.”

Discuss.

How does this Scripture apply to a person who genuinely loves God but who does not believe that he/she can tithe?

How does this Scripture apply to a person who genuinely loves God but who does not believe that he/she can be healed?

3. Hebrews 11:6 says, "...he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him."

Discuss Prong 1, which requires the believer to "believe that He is."

Discuss Prong 2, which requires the believer to "believe that He is a rewarder."

What does it mean to "diligently seek Him?"

4. The Pastor makes the argument that God is not a respecter of persons, but that God is a respecter of faith.

Discuss.

What do you think the Pastor means when he argues that God is a respecter of faith?
