MATTHEW 28:1-9 ESV

¹ Now after the Sabbath, toward the dawn of the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the tomb. ² And behold, there was a great earthquake, for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven and came and rolled back the stone and sat on it... ⁵ [T]he angel said to the women, “Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. ⁶ He is not here, for He has risen, as He said. Come, see the place where He lay. ⁷ Then go quickly and tell His disciples that He has risen from the dead... ⁸ So they departed quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to tell His disciples. ⁹ And behold, Jesus met them and said, “Greetings!” And they came up and took hold of His feet and worshiped Him.

COLOSSIANS 2:13-15 KJV

¹³ And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath He quickened together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses; ¹⁴ Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to His cross; ¹⁵ And having spoiled principalities and powers, He made a shew of them openly, triumphing over them in it.

1. In Sunday's message, Pastor MGB said that “a lot of Christians miss the significance of the resurrection because they are ‘stuck at the cross’.”

Discuss.

What do you think he means by suggesting that some Christians have been “stuck at the cross?”

2. Pastor MGB indicated that our victory in Christ is two-dimensional. He suggested that the cross is responsible for our reconciliation, while the resurrection is responsible for our restoration.

What is meant by “reconciliation?”

How does that relate to the cross?

What is meant by “restoration?”

How does that relate to the resurrection?

3. Pastor MGB indicated that through the Resurrection, God gave us victory over sin, sickness, poverty, and spiritual death.

If we have the victory over these things, why are so many believers in bondage to sin, sickness, poverty, etc.?

Is there anything they can do to walk in the victory that God has given them?

APPLICATION QUESTION

1. If you can admit that even as a Christian, you have missed the significance of the resurrection, what can you do differently from this point forward?
