**Subject: LOVE (Luke 10:25-29)**

**Week February 4-10, 2018: "The Good Samaritan" #What'sLoveGotToDoWithIt?**

**Pastor Rose Charley**

1. In this message, Pastor Charley teaches from the account of the Good Samaritan, where Jesus told the lawyer, that the man who was a stranger to the one who had fallen among thieves who beat him, stripped him, and left him for dead – was his neighbor.

What, other than the fact that the Samaritan helped him, made him the man's neighbor?

If God regards a complete stranger as your neighbor, who is not your neighbor?

2. Pastor Charley says "no matter who you are" ... "to inherit eternal life, you have to love."

Can you think of something that happened in your life that made it very difficult to love?

Can you admit to any instance where you haven't gotten there yet?

3. In Point 1 of the message, Pastor Charley teaches that you have to have love even for the folk who "floored you."

Can you identify any relationships you've had where someone has hurt you to the point where it floored you?

How do you walk in love when somebody hurts you to the point it floors you?

4. In her second point, Pastor Charley teaches that you have to have love even for the “holy who ignore you.”

Have you ever been in a position where you had to forgive and walk in love, when someone ignored you, although they could have helped you?

5. In her third point, Pastor Charley teaches that you even have to have love for the “heavenly that restores you.”

Have you ever had someone to help you who was a stranger to you?

How did you show love for that person?
