1. In Sunday's message, Pastor MGB notes that "all things start with a 'seed'."

Please discuss.

Why does he refer to this as a "Kingdom principle?"

2. Pastor MGB emphasized that it is important to prepare for the inheritance and for the promises that God has for us.

Why is it necessary to prepare ourselves to receive the blessings that God promises us in the Bible?

Is it possible to miss or lose a blessing that God has promised if not prepared to receive it? How so?

3. Pastor MGB used the analogy of a pregnant woman who starts preparing for the baby – to suggest that when we are pregnant with vision, dreams, desires, we should start preparing for the blessing.

Are there any things you want or need from God for which you have started preparing?

What preparations have you started making in order to receive your breakthrough and/or blessing?

What more can you do to get ready, be ready, and stay ready for the manifestation of the blessing?

4. Pastor MGB says we as a church need to “Get Ready! Be Ready! Stay Ready!” for our blessing.

What are some things that we as a Body can start doing to prepare for our move to our new location?

What can we do between now and the fall of 2019, when our lease ends, to prepare for our blessing?
