Check Your Cholesterol; Control Your Blood Pressure; Manage Diabetes; Take Medicines As Directed; Work with a Health Care Team.

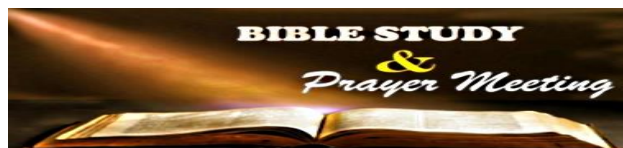
